## **Montana State Library Commission Policy**

## **Talking Book Institutional Policy**

The Montana State Library provides access to the Braille and Audio Reading (BARD) service and loans a circulating collection of recorded books and equipment to institutions or organizations which provide services to individuals who are eligible for Talking Book services.

## Requirements

All organizations or institutions interested in having a Montana Talking Books Account must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Complete the application for institutions service.
- 2. Provide a specific, secure physical location for any books or equipment on loan.
- 3. Designate one person to be responsible for materials to assure the following:
  - Books and equipment are made accessible to qualified users
  - Books and equipment are kept in good condition
  - The book collection and equipment will be returned if no longer being used by qualified individuals.

Eligible Montana institutions include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Residential centers providing services to qualified Montanans;
- 2. Medical facilities with patients receiving long-term care lasting a month or more;
- Centers providing day activities for qualified Montanans;
- 4. Montana Public Libraries;
- Schools serving qualified students.
